GAME CANCELLATION PROCEDURES

GAME CANCELLATION – BAD WEATHER

Umpires are to be called (number from Zebraweb.org) <u>NO LESS</u> Than <u>1</u> <u>HOUR BEFORE</u> scheduled game time. Opposing Coach should be called prior to Umpires notification

Email League Statistician Immediately with cancellation and reschedule date (games to be made up no later than the <u>Sunday of week of cancellation</u>).

Email Jon Adams at jasa60@aol.com with rescheduled date. League Statistician is also to be emailed immediately of reschedule date. League statistician will also email Jon Adams.

GAME CANCELLATION – OTHER REASONS

Games may be cancelled only for unreported School and Community dates and only if these dates make it impossible to field a team (first option is to bring up players). <u>NO CANCELLATIONS</u> will be allowed for any other reason (loss of field excepted). League Statistician <u>MUST</u> <u>approve cancellation</u>. Game IS NOT to be changed with opposing coach prior to league approval. Umpire IS NOT to be contacted prior to league approval. *Failure to follow this procedure will result in a suspension*

League Statistician is to be notified by Email <u>NO LESS</u> than 48 hours prior to proposed cancellation date. Upon <u>his approval</u> Jon Adams is to be emailed. League Statistician will also email Jon Adams.

Jon Adams <u>IS NOT</u> to be emailed prior to League Statistician's approval of game cancellation.

If a game is not rescheduled immediately upon cancellation date the League Statistician and Jon Adams are to be emailed when new date has been established. League Statistician will also email Jon Adams.

SCORE REPORTING

Winning coach is to email score (and pitchers, using last name and their innings pitched for <u>both</u> teams) to League Statistician <u>WITHIN 24 HOURS</u> of completion of the game.

JON ADAMS IS <u>NOT</u> TO BE CALLED FOR ANY REASON OTHER THAN UMPIRE NO-SHOW BEFORE A GAME HE IS NOT TO BE CONTACED ABOUT UMPIRE'S CALLS OR RULE INTERPRETATIONS. EMAIL GARY METZGER IN THE EVENT OF A RULES INTERPRETATION OR PROTEST.
